# Available Programs

## **FORKLIFT OPERATOR TRAINING COURSE -**

This course is designed for anyone who wants to be qualified to operate a lift truck. Through this course you will learn lift truck fundamentals, stability, daily checklists, safety and hands on operation. You will be given a safety handbook, video, test, certificate, and operator's permit.

## **RECERTIFICATION -**

This course is designed for the operator who needs to be re-certified for a forklift and MEWP operator's permit. This is a 2-hour course including a written exam and a hands on evaluation.

## **MEWP TRAINING -**

This course is designed for individuals who want to be qualified in operating a mobile elevated work platform. This class includes a discussion of fundamentals, safety, and parts of a MEWP. It also includes a video, test, and hands-on operation.



# Training Classifications

## Forklift Classification

### Classes 1, 4, and 5: Electric and Internal Combustion Engine Trucks:

Includes electric motor rider trucks (Class 1), internal combustion trucks with solid cushion tires and/or pneumatic tires (Class 4 and 5). Used in a range of environments including indoor and outdoor settings, these forklifts are suitable for general material handling.

### Class 2: Electric Motor Narrow Aisle Trucks:

Designed for narrow aisle use, includes reach trucks and order pickers.

### Class 3: Electric Motor Hand or Hand-Rider Trucks:

Includes pallet jacks and walkie stackers, typically used for loading and unloading at ground level.

### Class 7: Rough Terrain Forklift Trucks:

Equipped with large tires for uneven ground, used in construction and agricultural settings.
